## Notes:

1. The "Responsible Entity (1)" is responsible for providing an accurate CWD: this is usually the person in Australia who engages the road carrier or offers the container for transport by road in Australia.

2. Separating the weight of the container and its contents ensures there is no confusion as to whether the declared weight is a net weight or gross weight.

3. This enables the person who is relying on the CWD to determine its likely accuracy.

4. CWD details could be included in another document e.g. the import delivery order (DO), the Electronic Import Delivery Order (EIDO), or provided separately.

5. The contents of the CWD must be readily available to an authorised officer or police officer who seeks to ascertain its contents, there and then in the presence of the container (whether by examining documents located on or in the vehicle or by obtaining the information by radio or mobile or other means).

The Container Weights Declaration (CWD) is a statutory requirement for all container movements (full or empty) and <u>should be received by AGS World Transport no later than the day prior to the scheduled movement</u>.
